## 34<sup>th</sup> Thames Traditional Boat Rally - 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> July 2011

### **Booking Conditions for Traders and Exhibitors Societies / Clubs / Charities**

1. The Rally organisers reserve the right to accept or decline applications for Trade or Exhibition space and also to determine the allocation of tent and site positions. The Chairman's decision on all matters shall be final and binding.
2. There shall be no unauthorised raffles, collections or games of chance.
3. Display or distribution of leaflets and all advertising/publicity material is restricted to the area allocated to each Trader or Exhibitor only. Leafleting of cars windscreens or boats is not permitted.
4. **No vehicle or gazebo is permitted at any time within 60ft of the riverbank (i.e. between the tents and the river). The Rally organisers will seek to recover any compensation which becomes payable to the site owners in respect of damage to the ground surface.**
5. **Between 10.00 and 18.00 on Saturday and Sunday all vehicles are to be parked in the Trader / Exhibitors allocated space in the main car park.**
6. All Traders and Exhibitors are responsible for the security of their own property at all times.
7. All Traders / Exhibitors and their staff must wear a valid wrist band for the Rally, which should be in evidence at all times.
8. **No barbeques are allowed within 60ft of the river. (There is a plastic mesh in the ground to counteract any erosion; it will melt.) No barbeques are to be left unattended at any time anywhere on the site. Open fires are not permitted.**
9. No part of the stand or exhibit should extend beyond the front of the allocated tent or space.
10. Setting up may start from **14:00 on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July** and must be complete by 09:00 on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July.
11. Tearing down may not begin before 17:00 on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> July, and must be complete by 12:00 on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July.
12. Trade rubbish must be placed in the bins provide and cardboard boxes "flat-packed".
13. Traders and Exhibitors must at all times have due regard for public safety.
